



Applications are accepted between June 1 and October 30

The **Investing in our Future Student Scholarship** fund was developed to recognize and support the next generation of chiropractors. The scholarship recognizes academic excellence, clinical competency and service to educational institutions and/or communities. Each year, the ACAC awards a **\$2,000** scholarship to one successful student applicant.

Eligibility

To qualify for the **Investing in our Future Student Scholarship**, applicants must be Alberta residents currently enrolled at a CCE-accredited chiropractic college.

Additional eligibility criteria include:

- **Clinical competency.** This is based on your submission of clinical-related courses or research including the grade attained and confirmation/reference by your professor.
- **Essay submission.** Why you chose chiropractic as a profession (minimum 1000 words).
- **Service activities.** A record and confirmation of your service activities to your CCE-accredited college and your community (e.g., involvement in service groups, college related activities and college committees).
- **GPA** achieved for trimesters seven through nine inclusive or your third year
